

# Birds Flying High

Part	Counts	Moves
A1	6 10	In Becket: Half hey, larks start, pass left, robins push back into Neighbor swing
A2	4 12	Form a ring, balance ring Give and Take to Larks side, Swing partner
B1	8 8	Robins pass right, left shoulder round neighbor halfway Long lines, larks roll <b>next</b> robins on the way back
B2	8 8	Mad robin, larks in front Larks chain left, CW courtesy turn

**Notes:** I recommend a floor demo for the B1 figure. It's the same path as a robin's RH chain without hands. Left shoulder round happens until the robin is facing in, then larks turn in, neighbors link inside hands, and form long lines in one fluid motion.

The mad robin may take less time than written, don't stop momentum, move smoothly into the chain + hey figure, the extra time will be taken up by the swing. Go ahead and start the 1/2 Hey early if the Larks are facing each other before the end of B2.

The Larks LH Chain can be danced either as a typical chain with a CW courtesy turn, or an open chain where an allemande right replaces the CW courtesy turn
